2007 CACA ECS In-Class Speech Contest Scoring Rules

- 1. The designated three Judges and one Timer of each class need to be at the school on time on 11/7. (The Timer should prepare a stop watch or a watch that can tell seconds.)
- 2. The three judges and timer will tally every contestant's scores in each category, calculate the total scores, and determine the ranking.
- 3. The two contestants with the topmost total scores will be the winners. They will enter the Intramural Speech Contest automatically.
- 4. If two contestants have the same total scores, the one with higher score in the <u>Skill, Composure</u>, or <u>Content</u> category, in the order mentioned, will be the winner.
- 5. Each Language Class teacher please fill the Top 2 Winner list by 3:00 PM and send it to the Coordinator Ken Yeh, or his designated assistant, in Cafetorium.
- 6. For fairness, the 15 Language classes will be classified into two Segments. Segment A's judges and timer will score the corresponding class in Segment B, and vice versa. The details are as follows,
